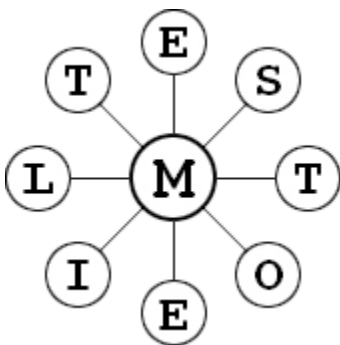
Using the Brain Tracker grid below, how many words can you find?
